Phonics	We will be concentrating on common exception words again this week. For today, we would like you to practise writing the following words: home, house, friend Write them three times and then put them into sentences.
English	Today is the day you become an author and write your story! Remember it needs to be about an animal who is scared of something, such as a cow scared of grass or a worm scared of going underground. Look back at your plan from yesterday to help you write your story. Don't forget the writing toolkit we talk about in school: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Capital letters at the beginning of sentences and for names</li><li>• Spaces between words</li><li>• Full stops at the end of sentences</li><li>• Use 'and' to join two sentences but no more than two in a sentence.</li><li>• Neatest handwriting</li><li>• Use adjectives to make your writing more interesting</li></ul> Good luck and have fun!
