Phonics	This week, we will be concentrating on common exception words. For today, we would like you to practise writing the following words: people, water, again Write them three times and then put them into sentences.
English	Today we are thinking of more adjectives to say how we feel about the dark and give reasons why for example I think that dark is calming because people are asleep and it is quieter than the daytime. Think of four adjectives (you can use the ones in the book or think of your own) to describe the dark and give your own reason for each one. Write these as sentences like the one above.
Maths	Lines of symmetry Watch WR video on vertical lines of symmetry. https://vimeo.com/508430942 Draw or print out some 2D shapes. Can you fold them or colour them to show if they can be halved along their vertical line of symmetry? Where is the vertical line of symmetry? What does vertical mean? Did you know you can use a mirror to see if your shape is symmetrical? Sort your shapes into 2 columns: line of symmetry/no line of symmetry If you have access to the website complete today's maths sheet
D&T	This week in Design and Technology we would like to explore the taste and texture of dips. If you are able to, taste a variety of dips, perhaps with a breadstick, then use your senses to describe the smell, taste and texture. Which dip is your favourite and why? <i>As a challenge can you find out which country your dip comes from?</i>
PE	Can you try out different ways of jumping - a straight jump, a star jump, a jump with a half turn? Remember to bend your knees and land on the balls of your feet.
