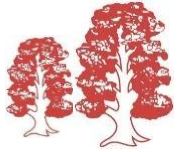


Elmtree Home Learning Summer Term 2 2020

<p><u>Handwriting</u> Write down three things you are grateful for. You could turn this into a "gratitude tree" and ask other people in your family to add to it. Everyone has to write neatly and clearly.</p>	<p><u>Reading</u> Read a favourite book that makes you feel happy. Maybe you could then read that book to somebody else to make them feel happy.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Write the numbers one to ten in words. Cut the words out and make an odd group and an even group. Can you try with the numbers eleven to twenty?</p>	<p><u>Phonics</u> Can you make a list of words which start with the prefix un. unhappy uncomfortable</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Close your eyes for two minutes. Make a list of all the things you heard in two minutes. Write down the new things you have been able to do in lockdown e.g. Walks and cycling.</p>
<p><u>DT</u> Make a little twig raft. Get various sticks and string. Think about the design, how big or small. How will you attach it? Can you add a sail? Could you test it (with adult supervision) in a nearby stream, pond, paddling pool, bath? Did it work? How could you improve it?</p>	<p><u>Wellbeing</u> Think about all the people in the community who are helping us at the moment. What would you say to them? What could you do for them?</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Learn at least 5 words of a new language. Decide on a language for the day and learn the words for hello, thank you, and any others you want to know. Give a prize to whoever remembers the most words the next day.</p>	<p><u>Art</u> When the sun shines this week create a shadow version of your favourite toys. Get a toy (animals work well) and a piece of paper. Cast a shadow, draw round the shadow outline. You could now add colour/tone or texture.</p>	<p><u>Writing</u> Ask each person in your household to say, type or write one line as you make a silly story together. You could all start with a piece of paper write the beginning fold over and pass it to another person.</p>
<p><u>Music</u> Listen to a song and have a sing along together. Get your body moving! Play a song and have a dance. Create your own funniest family dance!</p>	<p><u>PE</u> Play the beans game - when someone shouts out a type of bean, everyone else has to do the action. Baked bean: crouch down in ball, Runner bean: run on spot, Jumping bean: jump up and down, Magic bean do anything you like!</p>	<p><u>Spelling</u> Happy spellings Make a huge list of "happy" words. Make them into a word search for your family to solve.</p>	<p><u>History</u> During this month we have the longest day. Research Glastonbury then build your own. Go on a stone hunt and find different size/ shape stones. Can you balance them into towers and see how high you go.</p>	<p><u>PSHE</u> Ask your parents or carers for a job that would really help them out. Video call someone you know is feeling a bit lonely. Have a tidy up donate toys, clothes or food to people in need. Send someone you haven't seen a card.</p>
