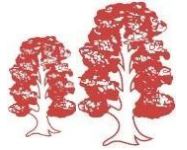

<p><u>Handwriting</u></p> <p>Can you use your best handwriting to write a shopping list for the weekly shop or write a list of the things that you have in your fridge.</p>	<p><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Can you read the Bug Club books? If you cannot access Bug Club, then read a magazine or comic. Can you identify 6 adjectives in the book you read?</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Can you create your own multiplication poster for the 2's, 5's, 10's and 3's? Make it as colourful as possible and decorate it with pictures to help you remember.</p>	<p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>With an adult think of 10 words in the present tense. e.g. walk, dance, laugh Can you then write them in the past tense? (Remember in school we looked at words that have the -ed suffix e.g. walked.)</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Did you plant something last week? Has it grown? Have you watered it? Can you write the instructions for planting your seed. Tell someone the 3 things it needs to grow.</p>
<p><u>D&T</u></p> <p>Design and make your own boat that will float on water. Plan what materials you are going to use and what your boat will look like. You might want to test your materials to see if they will float or not.</p>	<p><u>Wellbeing</u></p> <p>Make an A to Z of things that make you happy. You could write words, draw pictures or cut images out of old magazines and newspapers</p>	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Create a fact file on a country of your choice. You could do this on paper or a computer. You could include: Where it is (map), capital city, flag, weather/climate/animals /food etc.</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Make a face! You don't need paper and pencils. Create a face out of anything. Food, and leaves, objects from around the house.</p>	<p><u>Writing</u></p> <p>Find between 3 and 5 different objects in 3 different rooms in your house and write them in a list using commas. e.g. In my bathroom I have shampoo, a toothbrush, towels and a toilet roll.</p>
<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Explore and create. Get a few scraps of paper. Can you use the paper to make a snake slithering in the grass, raindrops landing on the roof, wind in trees. How did you make the sounds?</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>Set up a circuit in the garden or inside. Decide what to do at each station. e.g. Jumping Jacks, squats. Can you think of your own and make up your own names.</p>	<p><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>Write 5 sentences using the word: and, but, when, so because Can you remember what we call these words at school?</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Can you try to find out about Florence Nightingale? What was she famous for? How long ago did she live? Can you draw a picture of Florence?</p>	<p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>Create a card for someone you haven't seen for a while. Can you do drawings including pictures of what makes them special and what you miss about them?</p>
