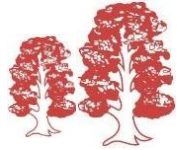

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Handwriting</u></p> <p>Can you use your best handwriting to write a letter to one of your friends from school to ask how they are?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Can you read the Bug Club books? If you cannot access Bug Club, then read a magazine or comic. Can you read aloud to a grown up?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Can you draw a clock and make a time? You can use things from around the house. Start with o'clock and half past. Move on to quarter past and quarter to. Challenge yourself and start counting in 5 minute intervals.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Can you think of any trigraphs? How many do you know? Make a list and try to think of words which have that trigraph in them. E.g. <u>more</u>, <u>hear</u></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>Can you plant some seeds in the garden or a small pot? What will the seeds need to grow? Take a picture and draw what you think they will grow into.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>D&T</u></p> <p>Can you create something out of paper? A boat, an aeroplane or a lantern? Take a picture of your creation and send it to the school blog.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Wellbeing</u></p> <p>Can you practise yoga? Sit quietly with your eyes closed. Listen very carefully to your breathing. Breathe in and out very slowly. Can you breathe deep in your tummy?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Make a list of the 7 continents. Write one fact about each. Can you sing the continents song? This may help you to remember.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Art</u></p> <p>Explore textures around your house. Can you make a wax rubbing by laying a piece of paper over a bumpy surface then rubbing over the paper with a wax crayon?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Writing</u></p> <p>Write a poem about what you have been doing at home. Use some adjectives, nouns, verbs and adverbs. You may want to rhyme some of your words.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Music</u></p> <p>Can you make your own instrument using objects from around your house? Can you play a tune?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE</u></p> <p>Use a timer to find out how long a minute is. Can you run on the spot for one minute? How many hops can you do in 1 minute? Do you need to change legs?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>Can you remember what a homophone is? Write as many down as you can. Look at the different spellings and practise these words in sentences. Son and sun, here and hear</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>History</u></p> <p>Can you try to find out about Grace Darling?
