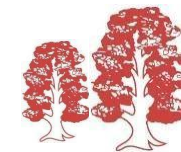

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Handwriting</u></p> <p>Practise writing the sounds and words: wh who, when, what ou should, could, would. How many more words using these sounds can you think of? Write a list.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Re-enact your favourite story with or to someone in your house. This could be a puppet show.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Can you make a role play shop so that your household can pretend to buy different things? How much money have you got? What other coins could you use to make an amount? How much change do you need to give?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Make a long line of items beginning with the first letter of your name. Can you write a list of the objects that you find? Use your phonics to help you spell the objects.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>Find a variety of objects and materials in your home. Draw a table and write whether the objects bend, twist, stretch or squash.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>DT</u></p> <p>Create an animal mask using different materials around the house. Think about colour, shape and features. Can you add different textures to your mask?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Wellbeing</u></p> <p>Learn how to tie shoelaces. Ask an adult to help you. Do you know you could use an egg box and a piece of string to practise?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Find out your address. Does your house have a name or number? Can you learn your address so you remember it?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Art</u></p> <p>With your eyes shut draw a self- portrait. You have as long as you can keep your eyes shut for. Don't forget all of your features.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Writing</u></p> <p>What is your favourite chocolate bar? Write an advert to persuade someone why they should try it. Try and use interesting adjectives to describe how it tastes and looks.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Music</u></p> <p>Create a steady beat using different things in your home (tapping a table, clapping your hands) Can you ask somebody to copy your pattern and rhythm adding to it each time.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE</u></p> <p>Holding a spoon in each hand throw a small object with one spoon and catch it with the other spoon. Hold the spoons about 1 metre apart to challenge you.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>Ay, a, a-e sounds Write these words and cover them can you remember how to spell them? Monday, holiday, behave, mistake, able, staple, complain, germinate</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>History</u></p> <p>What is Remembrance day? When is it? Why do we celebrate it? What is VE day how is this similar and different to Remembrance day. Talk about it with your family.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>Make a poster about keeping healthy. Remember to include bright colours, a title, information and pictures. Think about healthy eating, exercise, hygiene and water.</p>
