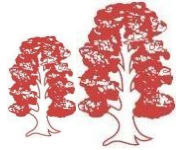

Remember to give it a star rating and a recommendation.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Choose 2-digit numbers and write out the different ways you can make them. Are your numbers odd or even? 28 is 28 ones or 2 tens and 8 ones or 20+8</p>	<p><u>Phonics</u> Can you think of the vowel 'e'? How many different ways can you write the sound e? Which words do you know with the sound 'e'? Make a list.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Cut out pictures of flowers, plants, bulbs and trees from a magazine Can you create your own collage flower? Can you label the parts of the flower?</p>
<p><u>DT</u> Create a healthy school dinner menu. Remember to think about healthy choices and different food groups. Draw a poster advertising your delicious menu.</p>	<p><u>Wellbeing</u> Have a laughing day - find different ways to make each other laugh - tell jokes, pull funny faces or make up silly stories.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Draw a map of your house. Can you add all the rooms and label objects in each room? Can you plan a route between rooms?</p>	<p><u>Art</u> Create a piece of art showing the four seasons of the year. Can you write a sentence about each season?</p>	<p><u>Writing</u> Write a story, about a superhero. Remember to include characters, a setting, a problem and a resolution. Draw your superhero first to help you.</p>
<p><u>Music</u> Listen to your favourite song and try to learn the lyrics. Can you create a dance to go with your song?</p>	<p><u>PE</u> How many jump jacks can you do in 10 seconds? How many squats can you do in 10 seconds? Try to beat your total every day.</p>	<p><u>Spelling</u> Write these words out then cover them up. Can you remember how to spell them? every, everybody, everyone, behind, because, beautiful</p>	<p><u>History</u> Can you create a fact file about Neil Armstrong? What was so important about Neil Armstrong?</p>	<p><u>PSHE</u> Close your eyes and think of a happy place. Where is it? What does it look like? Draw your scene.
